The Laredo Shrine Club, a club of Alzafar Shriners based in San Antonio, stands at the ready to coordinate with their brothers across the border in Mexico to transport patients. "We work as a team across international borders to ensure safe travel for these kids," said Rick Reyes, Potentate of Alzafar Shriners. He praised the quick communication between Alzafar Shriners, the Laredo Shrine Club and their brothers in Mexico. For Reyes, the accomplishment spoke not only of their effective collaboration, but also to their shared compassion, friendship and collective willingness of spirit to help those in need. "All these attributes are common in Shriners everywhere. Having the opportunity to assist in any way possible, it goes a long way. That's what we do as Shriners," Reyes said. "We're wearing the Fez. 





